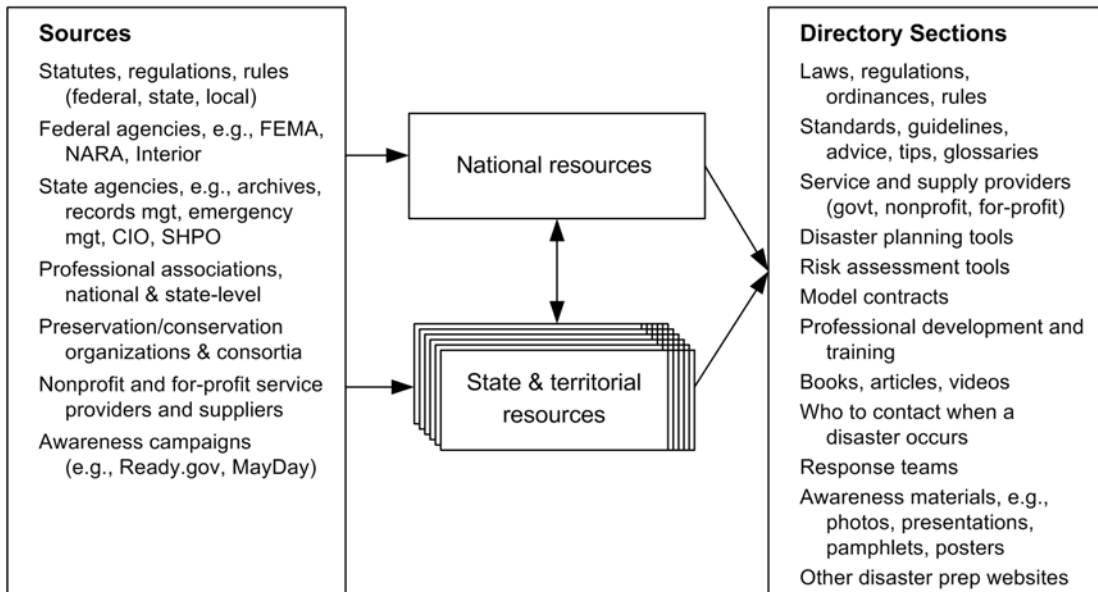
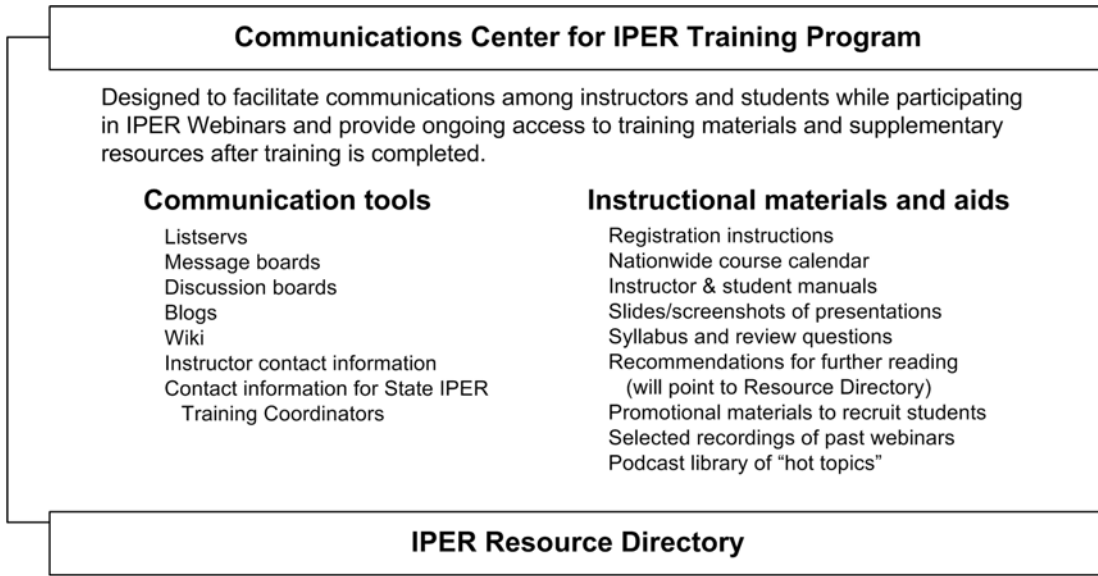


## IPER COMMUNICATIONS AND RESOURCE CENTER
