

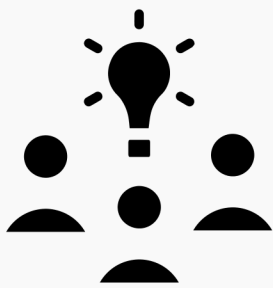
CoSA Membership
